

WANTZ CHEVROLET 'CAMARO' DICE ROLL CONTEST

OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. PURCHASE DOES NOT IMPROVE CHANCES OF WINNING. THE FOLLOWING CONTEST IS OPEN TO LEGAL RESIDENTS OF U.S. ONLY, WHO MEET THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS (AS DEFINED IN THE RULES BELOW). VOID ELSEWHERE AND WHEREVER PROHIBITED.

Promotion Period: Contest registration is scheduled to begin on **10/1/11 and end 12/31/11** (the "Registration Period"). The grand prize contest event is scheduled to occur on **1/21/12 at Wantz Chevrolet located at 1 Chevro Dr., Taneytown, MD 21787**. The contest is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations and is void where prohibited.

Who May Enter: Contest is open to legal U.S. residents, who reside within 250 miles of **Taneytown, MD** and are age 18 or older as of date of entry with a valid driver's license, except the following classes of persons who are not eligible to enter:

- (a) Employees, officers, and directors of **Wantz Chevrolet** ("Sponsor"), each of their respective franchisees, affiliated companies, subsidiaries, distributors, retailers, printers, advertising and promotion agencies, and any and all other companies associated with the design or execution of this contest (collectively, "Released Parties") and the members of the immediate families or households of any of the above, whether or not related. "Immediate family members" includes, for purposes of this contest, parents (including in-laws), grandparents, siblings (including step-siblings), children (including step-children), grand children (including step grand children) and each of their respective spouses.
- (b) Individuals who are unable or unwilling to visit participating sponsor location to enter, or to be present for the grand prize contest event scheduled to occur on **1/21/12**.

How to Enter – Three Ways:

1. **Entry Blank:** Official entry forms will be made available (while supplies last) at Wantz Chevrolet during normal business hours during the Registration Period.. Fully complete an official entry form with all required information including your name, address, phone and email. Deposit completed entry into the official registration box provided at sponsor location. No photocopied or mechanically reproduced entries permitted. All eligible entries must be received by **close of business on 12/31/11**. Limit one entry per person per day. Incomplete or illegible entries will be disqualified.
2. **Online:** To enter via on-line entry, visit www.wantzchevrolet.com during the "Registration Period" and click the Sweepstakes entry button to connect to the Sweepstakes registration page. Each entrant must fully complete the registration page with all required information including his/her name, complete address, valid email address, birth date, and phone number(s) (including area code(s)). After having read and agreed to these Official Rules, click the submit button to submit your on-line entry. All on-line entries must be fully complete for all required information. Maximum of one on-line entry per person or per valid email address. Any on-line entry submitted with an invalid email address will be disqualified. All eligible online entries must be submitted by 11:59pm ET 12/31/11.
3. **Qualified Purchases -** Eligible customers who purchase a qualifying **vehicle from Wantz Chevrolet** during the registration period will receive an entry into the grand prize drawing. Eligible customers must have purchased a qualifying **vehicle** out of existing dealer stock of inventory, completed all financial requirements including any down payments or payments due at signing, been approved for any and all required credit or financing, and taken delivery of qualifying **vehicle** prior to the end of the registration period (close of business on **12/31/11**).

Maximum of one entry per person per entry method. Incomplete or illegible entries will be disqualified. Released Parties are not responsible for lost, late, misdirected, illegible, incomplete, invalid, unintelligible, damaged, or postage due mail or entries or for lost or stolen entries boxes, or for entries submitted in a manner that is not expressly allowed under these rules, or for any entry not submitted or received due to any technical error or failure, unauthorized human intervention, inaccurate capture or mis-entry of any required information, or the failure to capture any such information or effects of hackers or failure of any electronic equipment, computer transmissions and/or network connections; all of which will be disqualified.

Each participant must submit an entry on his/her own behalf. Any entry submitted on behalf of another individual or using another person's email address or name will be disqualified and ineligible to claim any prize. Any attempt by any participant to obtain more than the stated number of entries allowed by using same, multiple/different email addresses, identities, or any other methods void that participant's entries and that participant may be disqualified. No mechanically reproduced or automated entries permitted. Use of any automated system to participate is prohibited and will result in disqualification and all such entries will be deemed void.

In the event of a dispute as to any on-line registration, the authorized account holder of the e-mail address used to register will be deemed to be the registrant and he/she must be eligible according to these Official Rules. The "authorized account holder" is the natural person assigned an e-mail address by an Internet access provider, online service provider or other organization responsible for assigning e-mail addresses for the domain associated with the submitted address. All entries received become the property of the Sponsor and will not be returned.

Finalist Selection & Notification: A random drawing will be held on or about 1/15/11 from among all eligible entries received to select a total of (200) finalists. These selected finalists will be notified by phone of their selection. Any selected finalist that cannot be reached or contacted to confirm their selection after an initial phone call to the number listed on their entry, may be disqualified and an alternate finalist will be selected and notified, time permitting.

Any selected finalist who does not meet the eligibility requirements, does not wish to participate in the grand prize contest, or who is unable or unwilling to attend the grand prize event will be disqualified. An alternate finalist will be randomly selected per the procedures outlined above, time permitting. Only the finalists selected and notified by sponsor will be eligible to participate. All other entrants are ineligible. Finalist selection and participation is non-transferable. **No other individual may participate on behalf of a selected finalist.** Decisions of judges in the selection of finalists, and all matters related to this contest are final.

Selected finalist(s) must be present at the date, time and location as specified by sponsor to participate in the grand prize contest (*scheduled for 1/21/12 at Wantz Chevrolet*). Any contestant who fails to appear by the required deadline will be disqualified, and will not receive any alternate contest attempts, prize substitution or compensation. Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to change the date, time or location of the grand prize contest. Finalists will be notified of any changes at the time of their selection and/or notification. **In the event a finalist fails to appear at the designated date, time and location for the grand prize contest, sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion to randomly select replacement finalists from anyone in attendance from the crowd on the day of the contest. Difficulties with getting to location to enter or participate in the contest are not the responsibility of Sponsors.**

Grand Prize Contest: In order for a grand prize to be awarded to an eligible finalist, the finalist must print and sign their full name on the first unoccupied line of the provided official finalist registration form prior to their dice roll attempt. Each finalist will receive a maximum of one (1) dice roll attempt. The eligible finalist must roll all (6) dice provided by Sponsor during each roll attempt, and have each die come to rest with the predetermined winning side face up. The winning symbols for this contest are: **C-A-M-A-R-O**.

Eligible dice roll attempt requirements

- All dice roll attempts must occur in the presence of the contest administrator(s), and must be recorded on video tape in its entirety. Any dice roll attempt not in the presence of the contest administrator, or that is not video taped for any reason will be disqualified and is not eligible for the grand prize;
- Finalists will not be permitted to take any practice or warm-up tosses prior to their attempt. Once a die has been rolled, their attempt is considered to be started.
- **Each eligible finalist must roll all 6 dice all at one time.** Finalists may not attempt to change the outcome of any rolled die, by hitting the die with a subsequent roll attempt;
- All (6) dice must be rolled on each individual contest attempt. The winning outcome must occur during a single roll attempt – i.e. contestants may not combine letters during multiple roll attempts. Each roll is its own unique contest attempt, and the (6) winning letters must all land face-up on a single roll.
- Each die must be tossed in a completely random manner that does not allow the finalist to “set” or “slide” the dice, alter or influence the random outcome of the roll;
- Each die must be rolled a minimum of two (2) feet in distance from the finalist, in order to prevent the finalist from altering, affecting, influencing, or enhancing the random outcome of any roll. The contest administrator will designate the demarcation line that each die must cross during the roll attempt;
- All dice must come to rest lying flat;
- All dice must land on and remain on the designated dice rolling surface;
- No rolled die may come in contact with any person or object other than the designated rolling surfaces or walls.
- If any die comes in contact with another person or object (other than the dice roll surface or designated walls or backstop) for any reason; or if any person or object in any way interferes, alters, changes, influences or affects the random outcome of the roll, then the entire attempt is disqualified and the finalist may not receive another attempt.

The following will result in the finalist being required to re-roll their entire dice roll attempt:

If any of the following outcomes occur, that dice roll attempt is disqualified and the finalist will be granted a maximum of one re-roll attempt (the finalist must re-roll all 6 dice):

- If the contest administrator deems that any die has failed to cross the dice roll demarcation line;
- If any die is leaning in any manner;
- If any die leaves the designated dice roll playing surface;
- If any finalist inadvertently drops a die as they are preparing to roll, and the dropped die does not meet the eligible dice roll requirements as stated in the contest rules.

In all circumstances, an eligible finalist may have a maximum of one re-roll for any faulted attempt. In the event of a second ineligible dice roll, that entire dice roll attempt will be disqualified and the finalist will not be eligible for any prize claim regardless of the outcome of that roll. If the prize winning requirements are not successfully completed by an eligible finalist, then the grand prize will not be awarded.

Prize Awards & Delivery: In the event of a successful dice roll attempt, the eligible contestant will be eligible to claim the grand prize subject to approval and verification of compliance with these Official Rules. Grand prize is a **2012 Chevy Camaro from Wantz Chevrolet vehicle with an approximate retail value (“ARV”) of \$30,000, not including sales tax.** Sponsor will solely designate and specify available vehicles including make, model, color and options for contestant’s prize selection. Selected vehicle must be one of the sponsor designated vehicles that are currently in sponsor’s stock of inventory.

A maximum (1) grand prize will be awarded. Contest is immediately concluded following the first successful attempt, regardless of the number of finalists remaining who have not participated in the contest. In the event that the grand prize winning contest requirements are not successfully completed by an eligible finalist, then the grand prize will not be awarded.

Winner must accept delivery of vehicle from the sponsor designated dealer, or as otherwise specified by Sponsor. Administrator will solely designate and specify available vehicle including make, model, color and options for Grand Prize winner's prize award. Grand Prize winner may not substitute, exchange, or apply the vehicle's value towards a higher cost or alternate vehicle. Designated vehicle must be the Sponsor designated vehicle that is currently in designated dealer's stock of inventory. Administrator reserves the right to award an alternate year model (*i.e.* 2010), if the 2012 model is not available at the time of prize award.

If the designated prize vehicle MSRP is under \$30,000, the winner will not be awarded the difference between the vehicle's actual MSRP and \$30,000. Grand Prize winner is responsible for paying any and all sales tax on prize award at time of delivery, estimated at approximately \$1,500 (based on a 6.0% tax value) but may vary depending on the state and county in which the vehicle is awarded.

All other costs and expenses related to prize acceptance and use not specified herein as being provided are the sole responsibility of Grand Prize winner, including but not limited to tax, title, insurance, license and registration fees. All income, federal, state and local taxes are Grand Prize winner's sole responsibility. All grand prize awards are non-transferable and no cash redemption or prize substitution allowed, except at Administrator's sole discretion or as provided herein. Administrator reserves the right to substitute a prize of comparable or greater value, at its sole discretion.

Winner(s) must accept delivery of prize from Sponsor, or as otherwise instructed by sponsor. All other costs related to prize delivery and acceptance are the responsibility of winner including but not limited to taxes, title, insurance, license, and registration fees. All properly claimed prizes will be awarded. Prizes are non-transferable and no cash redemption or prize substitution allowed, except at sponsor's sole discretion or as provided herein. Sponsor reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if an advertised prize becomes unavailable.

Winner(s) will be required to complete and return a W-9 form (*if prize value exceeds \$600.00*), affidavit of eligibility, and liability/publicity release, and present a valid driver's license and social security card before prize will be awarded. Winners of prizes greater than \$600.00 will be issued a 1099 form reflecting the value of the prize(s) and are responsible for paying all income taxes on prize(s). Failure to collect or properly claim any prize in accordance with these rules will result in forfeiture of the prize. If forfeited for any reason, contestant will not receive any other prize substitution or compensation. Total ARV of all prizes: **\$30,000.**

Additional Rules & Restrictions: By participating in this contest, entrants agree to abide by and be bound by the Official Rules and the decisions of the Administrator, which shall be final in all matters relating to this contest. In the event an entrant wins a prize, and is later found to be in violation of these rules he/she will be required to forfeit the prize or to reimburse Sponsor for the stated value of the prize if such violation is discovered after winner has used the prize. Participation in contest constitutes permission for the Sponsor and its agencies to use winners' names and/or likenesses for purposes of advertising and trade in any media worldwide without limitation or further compensation unless prohibited by law. False, fraudulent or deceptive entries or acts shall render entrants ineligible for any prize.

Sponsor and Administrator are not responsible for any typographical or other error in the printing or advertising of the offer, administration or execution of the contest or in the announcement of the prizes/prize winners. By accepting prizes, winners agree to hold sponsor, and released parties (collectively "Releasees"), from any claims, losses, actions, or damages of any kind, whether actual, incidental or consequential, for injury (including but not limited to death), damages, losses or expenses arising out of or relating to entrant's participation in this contest, or the acceptance, possession or use/misuse of any prize, or participation in prize-related activities (including but not limited to travel related thereto), and to assume all liability in connection therewith.

Releasees shall not be liable to any winner, entrant or any other person for failure to supply the prize or any part thereof by reason of any acts of God, any actions, regulations, orders, or requests by any governmental entity, equipment failure, terrorist acts, war, fire, unusually severe weather, embargo, labor dispute or strike, labor or material shortage, transportation interruption of any kind, or any other cause beyond Releasees' sole control. No more than the advertised maximum number of prizes will be awarded for any reason.

IN CASE OF DISPUTES: By participating, each entrant agrees that (1) any and all disputes, claims, and causes of action arising out of or in connection with this Promotion, or any prizes awarded, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and any judicial proceeding shall take place in a federal or state court within the State of New Jersey; (2) any and all claims, judgments, and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering this Promotion, but in no event attorneys' fees; and (3) under no circumstances will entrant be permitted to obtain awards for, and entrant hereby waives all rights to claim, punitive, incidental, and consequential damages, and any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses, and any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, or the rights and obligations of entrant and Sponsor in connection with this Promotion, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules or provisions (whether of the State of New Jersey or any other jurisdiction), that would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than the State of New Jersey.

Odds: The odds of winning the grand prize by successfully rolling the dice are: **1:46,656.**
